- (c) External Audit: The Council noted the successful conclusion of the external audit. Thanks were due to Bill Marshall for undertaking the internal audit.
- (d) **High Wray Village Hall**: in response to an application by the High Wray Village Hall Committee for funding towards refurbishment of the Hall the Council advised the Committee to apply at a time when their plans were more concrete. At the same time it advised the Committee also to look at alternative sources of grant funding.
